

Course Care

Bunkers:

- 1. Always enter the bunker at the lowest point.
- 2. Pull rake toward you as you exit the bunker.
- 3. If required, rake other affected areas.
- 4. Do not pile sand at the edge of the bunker. Push back excess sand.
- 5. Do not rake the face of the bunker. Smooth out with the back of rake.
