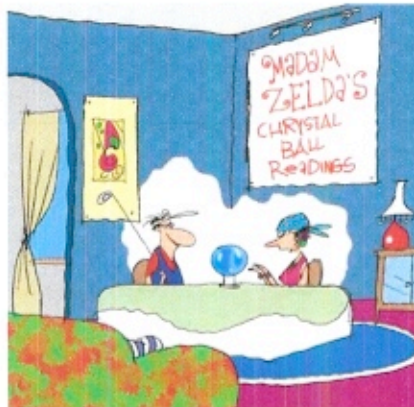

Cottesloe Golf Club formed in 1908, originally in Cottesloe. Relocated to the larger property in Swanbourne in 1931, where the new course was formed among the dunes. Thomson, Wolveridge and Perrott design company made significant changes to the layout in the early 1980s, then Graham Marsh (former Cottesloe club champion and now acclaimed architect) carried out a number of improvements in time for the club's centenary in 2008.

Cottesloe Golf Club is a private club and guests should be invited to play by a club member, unless they are visiting from overseas, in which case they may be introduced by the General Manager.
