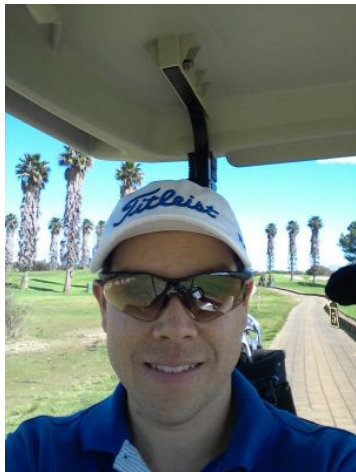
Other excellent scores included:
